NOTIFICATION

No. 3379 /En., Bhubanswar, dt. 27 March, 2020
ENG-RR-RR-0001-2020

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (4) of Section 3 of Odisha Electricity (Duty) Act, 1961 (Amended), the State Government do hereby exempt from payment of electricity duty on consumption of electrical energy either supplied by the DISCOM Utility or generated through captive power plants including generating sets to the premises setup under SEZ Policy, 2015 (within the processing area) till the period of availability of valid certificate of eligibility issued by nodal agency.

Accordingly the clause-1 of the earlier Notification of Energy Department bearing No.2767 dt. 11.04.2016 is hereby replaced.

The procedure to be adopted by the Developer / Co-Developer and SEZ units for availing exemption of ED is as follows.

1. The applicant unit shall submit the photo copy of the letter of Ministry of Commerce and Industry as a proof of validity / extension period of the approval granted under SEZ Policy to the concerned Chief Engineer-cum- Chief Electrical Inspector / the Superintending Engineer-cum-Electrical Inspector/ the Executive Engineer-cum-Deputy Electrical Inspector.
2. On receipt of the SEZ certificate, the Chief Engineer-cum-Chief Electrical Inspector / the Superintending Engineer-cum-Electrical Inspector/ the Executive Engineer-cum-Deputy Electrical Inspector shall sanction the exemption & intimate the same to Executive Engineer of concerned Electrical Division, Nodal Agency & the applicant unit in the prescribed format Annexure-7.
3. In case any exemption is allowed after collection of ED, the concerned Executive Engineer of DISCOM division shall take necessary steps to adjust the collection on account of ED against energy charges payable by the industrial unit in future bills after receiving refund adjustment order from concerned Chief Engineer-cum-Chief Electrical Inspector / the Superintending Engineer-cum-Electrical Inspector / the Executive Engineer-cum-Deputy Electrical Inspector.
4. The Chief Engineer-cum- Chief Electrical Inspector / the Superintending Engineer-cum-Electrical Inspector / the Executive Engineer-cum-Deputy Electrical Inspector who has sanctioned the exemption shall keep the accounts of exemption for each financial year. The CE-cum-CEI shall keep record of the quantum of benefit extended under SEZ policy of 2015.

This Notification will come into force retrospectively from 18.06.2015.
