Sir,

I am directed to invite reference to your letter No. 310 dt. 22.1.2021 and to say that Government after careful consideration of your proposal and taking note of difficulties being faced by the stakeholders owing to COVID-19, have been pleased to decide the following.

- (a) The relaxation earlier granted up to 30.6.2020 vide Energy Department letter No. 4081 dt. 22.4.2020 and up to 30.9.2020 vide Energy Department letter No. 6572 dt.28.7.2020 with regard to validity of Contractor License, SCC and Workman permit stands further extended up to 31.3.2021 without imposition of penalty.  
(b) The compliance to be made in respect of provision made vide Clause 31(A)(iv) of ELBO Regulations, 2014 also stands relaxed up to 31.3.2021.

The draft Guidelines may be revised accordingly and issued at the level of ELBO for information of all concerned.
