Sub: **Scheme Guidelines on "Green City Mission".**

1. Background
With an aim of reducing carbon footprint in the country, Ministry of New & Renewable Energy (MNRE), Govt. of India launched Solar Cities Programme in 2020 and selected "Capital City - Bhubaneswar" in the scheme.
2. Scheme /Programme objectives
Bhubaneswar City has been chosen by MNRE to be converted into solar city. The primary objective of this programme is to offset total electricity consumption of the city through various Renewable, Energy efficiency and Demand Side Management interventions thereby reducing the power costs and carbon footprint of the city to very low levels. Odisha's objectives for this program expands beyond the scope of a Solar city. The objective is to make Bhubaneswar a "**Green Energy City**".
3. Coverage under scheme / programme and duration
The scheme will be implemented within three years i.e. from 01.04.2022 to 31.03.2025 and will cover the followings:-
 1. Demonstration of use of solar PV system at important places such as Public Parks, Heritage sites.
 2. Provide subsidy for use of solar water heaters, solar pumps.
 3. Adoption of Energy Efficiency measures in Government buildings.
 4. Transaction advisory charges for adoption of RESCO model.
 5. Support for EV charging station.
 6. IEC on use of Green Energy, EV adoption etc.
4. Implementation of the scheme / programme (with definite role of the stakeholders at State / District / implementation level)
The scheme will be implemented through Odisha Renewable Energy Development Agency (OREDA), Bhubaneswar & TPCODL
5. Source of funding for the scheme / Project and fund flow mechanism
State funding for Rs.50.00 crore and the said funds will be placed with OREDA.
