NOTIFICATION

No. 5728 /En, Bhubaneswar, Dated the 26/05/2026
ENG-RR-RR-0003-2017

1. In exercise of the powers conferred under Sub-regulation (1) of Regulation 38 and Sub-regulation (2) of Regulation-45 of the Central Electricity Authority (Measures relating to Safety and Electric Supply) Regulations, 2023 and in supersession of all previous orders/instructions issued in this regard, the State Government hereby notifies the following with immediate effect.
 - i. All electrical installations connected with electricity at voltage up to 33 kV shall be self-certified by the owner/supplier/consumer as the case may be, through certified Chartered Electrical Safety Engineers (CESEs) as opted by the owner/supplier/consumer in accordance with the provisions of the Electricity Act, 2003 and the rules/regulations made thereunder.
 - ii. Notwithstanding anything contained in the above clause, the electrical installations covered under Section 54 of the Electricity Act, 2003 and the electrical installations of mines, oil fields and railways shall continue to be inspected and certified by the Electrical Inspector irrespective of voltage level.
 - iii. The periodicity of inspection of electrical installations, as prescribed vide this Department Notification No. 10317 dated 27.10.2022 shall continue to be in force for installations inspected by both the Electrical Inspectorate and CESEs.
2. Further, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Regulation (1) of Regulation-136 of the Central Electricity Authority (Measures relating to Safety and Electric Supply) Regulations, 2023, the State Government do hereby allow the electrical installations belonging to Odisha Power Transmission Corporation Limited (OPTCL) up to 765 kV voltage level shall be inspected, tested and self-certified by themselves before commencement of supply or recommencement after shut down for six months or more.
3. In partial modification to this Department Notification No-7753 dated 27.10.2016, the State Government do here by notify that no consumer or occupier shall commission his/her generating plant generating electricity from any source of energy of a capacity above 500 KVA without the written approval of the Electrical Inspector.


